You must be between the ages of 18-60 and fill out a short health questionnaire to participate. At the drive volunteers from the national Be The Match Foundation will do a quick cheek swab on those who attend. The majority of marrow donations involve only a blood draw.



Our recruitment efforts will add many names to the Be The Match Registry. Be The Match is a federally funded nonprofit organization that maintains a data base of volunteers willing to donate a portion of their marrow or blood-forming cells to patients in need of a transplant. The growth of the registry gives hope to the thousands of patients who are looking for a match.
